21/176.Council to discuss drainage grille in verge of Village Hall Wall

Cllrs T Wooldridge and S Cooper have inspected the site. Cllr T Wooldridge reported that keeping the drains clear is the responsibility of GCC Highways, and we have already been liaising with them about other blocked drains further down the Hazlecote Valley.

We have been promised that as soon as possible the jetting team will clear the drains already reported to be blocked and the team will also check all the other drains as far as the village hall. In the meantime, the Parish Council will clear the grilles pending the arrival of the Highways jetting

21/177.ltems to report

Cllr T Wooldridge gave an update to Bagpath Common re: ash die back

- Glos CC Highways have taken responsibility for the trees endangering the public
- Felling of trees is not prioritised for this financial year, it is hoped to take place in Autumn 21.
- A zoom meeting has been requested (with Glos CC) in advance of any works taking place to outline what is actually going to happen
- To minimise costs, trees felled may be left in situ

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Council raised questions over whether the best policy was to leave felled trees in situ, and what about the trees that do not form part of the highway verge.

Decision: Cllr T Wooldridge to go back to CDC asking if highways are taking responsibility for the verges, then who is taking responsibility for the rest of the Common.

It was further agreed that parishioners need to be kept informed prior to the commencement of any works. It was noted that Highways have promised a meeting in advance.
